SHOW REGULATIONS

GUN SHOWS

Obey all Federal, State and Local firearms and tax laws. Conduct business in an ethical manner and are expected to be present and staffed during entire public viewing hours of the show. Single day rentals may be available at regular rates.

NEACA Show Management, no solicitation, raffles, contests, billboards, announcements, etc. will be allowed. Leniency will not be shown.

Table covers. Rental consists of tabletop and directly beneath. All firearms must be covered before entering and unloaded. Loose, matching ammunition to firearm is expressly prohibited in show. All modern gun actions must be unloaded. Buyer requires buyer to have gun lock.

Handguns to the public will not be allowed at NEACA Shows. Obey all NICS Federal and State firearm laws. NEACA Shows are on an individual exhibitor basis. Table holders may receive one for bona fide employee or immediate family member. Badges are not counted against exhibitor badges, "state" badges are \$10.00, do not lose or forget yours.

If you vacate a table it will revert back to NEACA. Tables by 9:00 AM Show Time, may be resold by NEACA. NEACA will not be permitted nor worn exposed or in belt on show premises. NEACA is responsible for the safety of their displays and security of their displays. NEACA will provide 24 hour armed security for the shows. NEACA has appointed at each show to enforce NEACA and show regulations. Security porters is available but at exhibitor expense and at NEACA's discretion.

Registration forms must be signed and completely filled in and submitted to NEACA, Inc or its officers. Confirmation of registration should be received as soon as possible. For upcoming shows, a deposit is required for reservations, provided the full balance is received. Refunds will be made if received by written request. Wall tables are priced slightly higher than other tables. NEACA, Inc will do whatever in their ability to make the show a rewarding week-end to all but must insist upon the exhibitors, dealers and exhibitors to adhere to all General Regulations and benefit of all. NYS laws are applicable to all shows.

PROHIBITED ITEMS AND ACTIONS

- 1 Carrying of firearms in holsters, belt or pocket. No loaded firearms in Show.
- 2 Obey modern handgun ammunition sales regulations. Collector boxed ammo should be sealed. Loose collector ammo to be displayed as to prevent pilferage and accessibility.
- 3 No operative Class III weapons. No conversion to auto kits or plans, throwing stars; chukka sticks or related martial arts weaponry; switchblades, non-collector straight razors, etc. or Federal or State restricted items without proper license on display. NY State requires buyer to have gun lock for firearms purchase.
- 4 No Gun Powder, explosive devices, hand grenades, new fuse or primers, etc.
- 5 No Racial or Ethnic propaganda, explicit sexual content, current political pamphlets and material, nor advertising conflicting with NEACA Shows without prior approval!
- 6 No jewelry, cameras, tools, watches, books, minerals, stamps, coins, etc. that do not have a significant historical value and/or relationship to the shooting sport or outdoor sports or to militaria collecting. No flea market material or bulk non-related items.
- 7 NEACA Shows are primarily designed for the Gun and Militaria Collector, Re-enactor or Historian and as such we will discourage, though not prohibit, new firearms of current manufacture. Exhibitors of collector items will take preference over those with new, non-collectible items. NEACA Executive Officers feel legitimate Firearms Shops are where the hunter or shooter should find new guns and accessories and also where they should find better service for their needs. NEACA reserves the right to refuse table rental space.
- 8 No two-way radios, electronic devices, use of birdcalls, and use of AM/FM radios or TV's that may irritate neighboring exhibitors or interfere with security without prior NEACA approval.
- 9 Do not use racks or shelves with solid backs that extend over 24" from the tabletop. Open gun racks are permitted if they do not block the view of other exhibitors. Wall tables, if requested and available, will not be subject to this prohibition.
- 10 Do not use Flags or rags for table covers.
- 11 No smoking is allowed in building. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in exhibit hall except at previews or when expressly stated.
- 12 If any other item or items are deemed objectionable or inappropriate for display, the NEACA Master at Arms will ask for its removal and may enforce these general regulations by requiring offender's removal from show without recourse or refund.

DISPLAY AND FIREARMS SAFETY CHECKS

Prior to show time a safety inspection will be conducted by the MAA or his representative of all exhibits and firearms and a sale/display card will be issued and must be displayed. Chambers of all firearms entering the show will be checked. Exhibitors are to check chambers of guns before and after handling by a customer. We must be absolutely sure of all firearms being unloaded.
